These are very trying times, none of which the most of us have ever seen. Many businesses closed and people laid off. I do not know how our year will play out, but I am hoping that this too shall pass. For now, I just want all of you to be safe, and take care of yourselves and your families. That being said, at the time of this writing, there is a terrible pandemic, Coronavirus, also known as COVID-19, spreading across the Unites States which also includes the state of Kansas. Some are not surviving. In fact, again at this writing, the Governor of Kansas has just issued a statewide stay at home order for 30 days, for all except essential jobs and personnel that perform in those jobs. Prior to this order, the Most Worshipful Grand Master of Kansas issued an edict cancelling all Masonic functions in Kansas (which will be quoted in part, below.)

"The Council of Administration and I have been closely monitoring the situation in our country, our state, and our local communities regarding the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Your Grand Lodge leadership has received many communications from brothers who are genuinely concerned about how this national crisis will impact our organization.

Be advised that through the edict attached I am suspending all <u>in person Masonic Meetings and Degree Work</u> as well as <u>all Masonic Community Events</u>, including meetings at lodge halls by <u>appendant and concordant bodies</u>, until further notice. The edict does not include masonic funeral rites although coordination with the family should be taken to limit attendance to no more than the required participants. As this crisis persists in our state or if there are additional orders from governing authorities, your Grand Lodge leadership will reevaluate the situation and make further decisions.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds

- Most importantly, if you are sick or not feeling well, please stay at home
