

Ascension Day

May 13, 2021

On this day we observe an important day in the Christian calendar which commemorates our Lord Jesus Christ ascent into heaven.

Ascension Day is traditionally celebrated on the 40th day after Easter Sunday and is also known as the Feast of Ascension of Jesus Christ, Ascension Thursday, or Holy Thursday.

Ascension Day takes its name from the accent of Our Lord Christ, who ascended into heaven on this day.

I encourage you to read these three Biblical references: Mark 16: 14-19, Luke 24: 50-61 and Acts 1: 9-11

The story is that 40 days after the resurrection, Jesus and his disciples went to the Mount of Olives (just 400 yards from the Eastern wall of Jerusalem) Jesus promised his disciples that they would receive the Holy Spirit and asked them to stay in Jerusalem until the Holy Spirit come upon them.

Jesus then blessed them and ascended to heaven.

This holy day is celebrated all across the Christian faith. Orthodox Christians celebrate this this event a week latter than Protestants and Catholics because their Easter is a week later.

Our Brothers and Sisters in Christ of the Orthodox Church use the Julian

Calendar and thus have a different date.

The hymns that we sing in church are so descriptive and evoke much thought and emotions. I have one below.

O Christ, who hast prepared a place.

For us around Thy throne of grace,

We Pray Thee, lift our hearts above
