

HISTORY OF THE KING SOLOMON No.82 TABERNACLE IN ROMANIA

The history of this Order in Romania starts on 17th of August 2009, at the 62nd Triennial of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar held in Roanoke, West Virginia, USA, when Past Commanders Ştefan Mâşu, Gabriel Gherasim, Ştefan Mantea, Ionel Ciuclea, Petre Buneci, Gheorghe Stănescu and Ioan Baltag were admitted as members.





Following the discussions of Knight Priest Gabriel Gherasim (2013-2014) with the Most Eminent Grand Perceptor David Dixon Goodwin, in May 2014, Tabernacle King Solomon No. 82 was constituted in Romania. The first Eminent Preceptor was elected Knight Priest Ștefan Mantea and today the Tabernacle is presided by the Eminent Preceptor Gabriel Gherasim.
