The Sir Knights of Calvary Commandery #8 convened on May 14, 2022, at Chalcedony Lodge #6 in Holbrook to confer the Order of the Temple on two candidates. At 1307 the Acting Commander, Right Eminent Past Grand Commander Sir Knight Frank Edens, directed the Junior Warden to place the candidates, one at a time, into the Chamber of Reflection and superintend them until called for in the Asylum. After completing their time in the Chamber, the two companions were escorted through the usual seven years of preparation, and at 1530, Christian Mikul Evans and Gary Wayne Price were knighted as Calvary Commandery's newest Sir Knights.

This knighting was important to Calvary Commandery for at least two significant reasons. To begin with, it is the first time in recent memory that all the parts in the order were filled by Sir Knights who are members of Calvary Commandery, without any outside help. Second, it is the completion by the Winslow York Bodies of all the regular degrees and orders of the York Rite since September 2021, a period of eight months. During that same time, members of Calvary Commandery and the other Winslow York Rite bodies participated in degree work in two interstate festivals and assisted in multiple single degrees and orders with other bodies throughout the state. It is also noteworthy that while some of the candidates took one or more of their degrees and orders in group festivals, they returned to Winslow, Holbrook, and Show to fill parts in the same degrees within a month of having received the degrees themselves.

Our congratulations to the two newest Sir Knights, Christian and Gary, and also to all of the new members of the Winslow York Rite.
