At the February festival there were twelve candidates. Finally, I would like to thank all of the cast members. Being a statewide degree/orders festival there are almost forty names on my cast list so I will not mention them all here. Suffice to say that no degree festival could happen without the participation of the cast. And with so many cast members there are bound to be a few last-minute difficulties. I especially thank the companions and sir knights who were willing to take parts minutes before the start of a degree or order and soldier through a part they had no idea they were going to have to perform and had no time to practice for the part.

The next scheduled Land of Enchantment degree festival is for July 2023 with the exact weekend being worked out so as not to conflict with other events and to make sure the Scottish Rite Temple is available. We did not utilize the Temple for the degrees or orders, but being in an

adjacent building it was very convenient to stay in the dorm rooms that are available and inexpensive. It was nice to just walk across the parking lot and fall into bed at the end of the long day of degrees on Friday and roll out again for the early morning breakfast to start the orders on Saturday.
