GRAND COMMANDER'S MESSAGE

Greetings Sir Knights,

I am honored by the confidence you expressed at the 161st Annual Conclave of the Grand Commandery of Missouri. I will work tirelessly to steer your Grand Commandery over the coming twelve months.
