Illinois State News for March 2022

Greetings Sir Knights of Illinois,

It's hard to believe March is upon us. March is a very busy month for Illinois Templary. Inspections are plentiful around the State. As many are aware there is an Historic Meeting of the Grand Encampment at our East Central Department Conference. A Special Conclave has been called to address issues that arose after the Triennial held in Minneapolis last August. The Past Grand Commanders, Grand Commander and Grand Dais Officers have been summoned to attend on March 12 at 1:00PM in Ft. Wayne.
