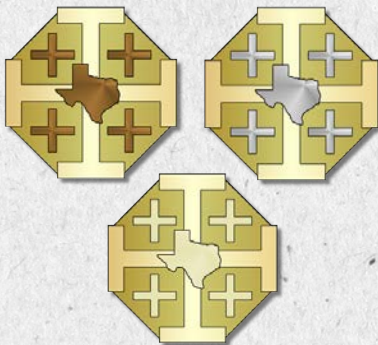
172nd Grand Conclave - April 2025

Holy Land Pilgrimage Foundation

The Grand Commandery is now offering, for a donation to the Texas Holy Land Pilgrimage Foundation, a Holy Land Pilgrimage Badge. This badge bears a Jerusalem Cross with the outline of Texas in the center being bronze, silver, or gold to denote the value of the contribution to the Texas Holy Land Pilgrimage Foundation, such that:



- Bronze Crosses in each quadrant - \$250 donation
- Silver Crosses in each quadrant - \$500 donation
- Gold Crosses in each quadrant - \$1000 donation

This Badge may be worn by the Sir Knight purchasing the same as a part of his Templar Uniform. It may be worn on the left side of the uniform above the pocket and the name tag and veterans ribbon, if applicable. **The first 100 Sir Knights to purchase a full badge shall receive a specially colored badge, which shall designate them as one of the Charter Donors.** The Holy Land Pilgrimage Badge may be worn on All Texas Templar Uniforms except the cap and mantle.

PRELATE'S CORNER



A MESSAGE FROM THE EMINENT GRAND PRELATE SK BRAD BILLINGS, KCT

Sir Knights,

If you've ever had hesitation, doubt, feelings of unworthiness, imperfections, weakness or fear you are NOT alone. When asked to serve as Grand Prelate I gave my usual response of "let me think and pray about it." While I feel this is the best advice anyone can utilize before making a decision, I must admit this time it was more of a way to pause while I found a way to respectfully decline the invitation. While I was thankful, excited even, for the awesome opportunity of filling a vital role within our Grand Commandery, I couldn't shake the feeling of unworthiness (which I still feel to this day).

As I prayed over the next few days one thought remained constant in my mind: God uses imperfect people! Moses couldn't speak well. David was an adulterer, and the argument can be made that he was a murderer too. Paul persecuted Christians. Peter denied Christ. Jacob stole his birthright. God's chosen people, the Israelites, despite being led out of captivity by a pillar of fire at night and a pillar of smoke during the day and even having seen the miracle of the Red Sea parted, chose to worship an idol. Even Solomon, the wisest man to ever live, and a key character in our Masonic journey, fell victim to the lust for women and wine. Permanent Endowment Fund

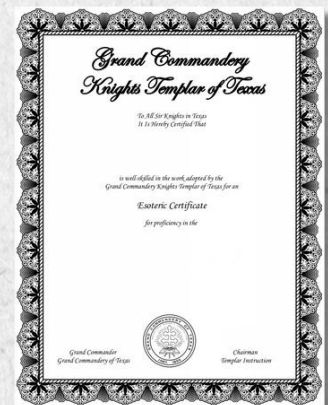

Member Citation Cord Awards

Any Sir Knight who has been the first line signer for a total of three petitioners, who are either knighted or restored to membership since January 1, 2016, is eligible to receive the Member Citation Cord Award. There are various levels represented by different colors, to show your quantity of recruitment or restoration. Those being restored to membership must have been off the active roll for a period of one year or more to qualify in the count. The total is cumulative with no time boundaries. When awarded with a cord, it is to be worn on your left shoulder.

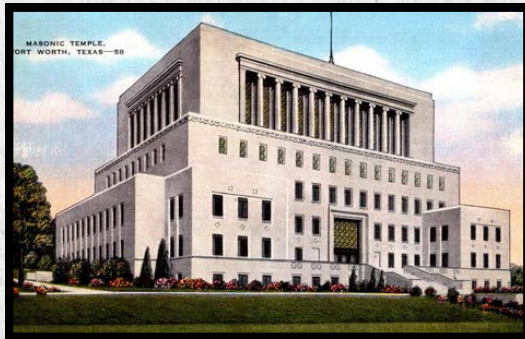
