

Saturday, December 7, next, the Grand Cryptic Council of New Hampshire will confer the Super Excellent Master Degree in Concord at 9:30 a.m. It was originally scheduled for October in Tilton, but had to be postponed due to a conflict with another event. This Cryptic degree is optional and fills some of the historical gap between the Most Excellent Master and Royal Arch Degrees. On account of the large cast required, it is conferred infrequently. If you are a Select Master who has not yet received the Super Excellent Master Degree, I encourage you to seize this opportunity.
