My pin is a copy of an 1850's Commandery pin from Philadelphia.



This pin centers and emphasizes with the Red Cross, meaning Christianity as the primary faith of the wearer, while recognizing the masonic love of the same God (Jehovah). Manly speaking, it is a very York Right oriented pin, being the Royal Arch and Cryptic Council are tied into the Old Testament, and the Commandery is primarily Christianity.
