## In Memoriam: REPGC Dale Douglas Davis



**New Bern** – On April 26, 2025, REPGC Dale Douglas Davis passed away after a courageous battle against cancer. Dale was raised to the Sublime Degree at St. John's Lodge No. 3 on May 10, 1995, in St. John's Lodge #3 in New Bern, NC, and served as Master in 2003. In 2013 he was elected as the Right Eminent Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery of North Carolina for the 2013-2014 term. Dale joined the New Bern Scottish Rite in November 1995, and was awarded the Knight Commander of the Court of Honour. He was the Past Director of the Chef Crew of the Scottish Rite. Dale was also the Past Director of the Sudan Chef Crew in 2003.

Graveside Services will be held on Monday, May 5, 2025, at 11:00AM at the <u>New Bern Memorial</u> under the Pavillion located at 1112 Chelsea Rd., Trent Woods, NC. Rev. Jeremy Slagle will be officiating the service. Military honors and Masonic Rites will follow the service. St. John's Lodge No. 3 uses the annual Lodge of Sorrow so there will not be a lodge meeting beforehand.
